COVID-19 REGULATIONS (Masks Recommended)

Although we know Covid-19 remains an issue we still want to give Louisville adults and outlet to compete, socialize, and celebrate. It is not possible to completely eliminate the risk but we will be sanitizing communal equipment between games as well as implementing the guidelines below as counter measures. Please maintain safe behavioral practices as reccomended by the CDC.

- 3. Do not enter the field of play until players from the previous game have left the field.

- 6. Be sure to sanitize your hands before and after your game.
- 7. Do not leave any trash or personal items behind.
- 8. Take temperature daily especially the day of your game.
- 9. Use personal coolers instead of communal coolers
- 10. Avoid touching other players personal items and refreshments.
- 11. No group celebrations, high fives, fist bumps, hugs, etc.
- 12. No sunflower seeds, chew, or spitting.
- 13. DO NOT COME if you are showing any symptoms of Covid-19.
